This is a project required for students enrolled in Psyc437/537 Fall 2009. The purpose of the project is to examine the relation between body metabolic condition and intertemporal choice preference. Each student needs to recruit and run 10 participants for the project. The recruiting procedure begins on Sep. 2 and ends on Sep. 18. Students could recruit whomever they think appropriate for the project and should collect contact information of the people recruited and report it to the coordinator of the project, Junyi Dai. Contact information should include full name, phone number and email address and be reported as soon as possible. Two training sessions will be offered during the third week of the semester so that students can get familiar with the related study to become an eligible experimenter. After that, each student should choose a timeslot of two hours (11am – 1pm or 5pm – 7pm) to complete the project no later than Nov. 30. The project accounts for 10% of the course total score. You will receive the full scores only when you have completed the recruiting and experiment requirements. The study will be conducted in SDU 213.
